

#### **OBSERVATIONS**

#### LLDPE Warehouse

• Pellets observed around concrete culverts at southwest corner of the warehouse.

#### PE1/PP1 Bagging/Shipping

- Pellets observed in ditch west of bagging/shipping building.
- Pellets observed behind stacked pallets up against building.
- Northside of building, pellets observed under grating and also on pavement from cracks in the building wall.
- Powder observed in ditch at southeast corner.

#### PE1/PP1 Railcar Loading

• Pellets observed on pavement in hopper car cleaning area.

#### LLDPE Warehouse

AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE WAREHOUSE, PELLETS WERE OBSERVED UP AGAINST THE CONCRETE CURB AS WELL AS NORTH OF THE CONCRETE CULVERTS.

CLOSER IMAGE OF PELLETS NORTH OF CULVERTS.



WEST OF THE BAGGING/SHIPPING BUILDING, PELLETS WERE OBSERVED IN A SECTION OF THE DITCH. UPON CLOSER INSPECTION, OBSERVATION WAS MADE THAT PELLETS HAD BEEN SWEPT UP INTO A PILE BUT NOT YET PICKED UP.





WEST OF THE BUILDING BEHIND THE PALLETS, PELLETS WERE OBSERVED COMING FROM INSIDE THE BUILDING THRU CRACKS IN THE OUTER WALL.





SIMILAR TO THE PREVIOUS SLIDE JUST FURTHER NORTH OF THE PALLETS, PELLETS WERE OBSERVED AROUND A CRACK IN THE OUTER WALL.





ON THE NORTH SIDE OF THE BUILDING AT THE DOOR. ATTEMPTS TO STOP THE PELLETS FROM TRAVELING OUT OF THE BUILDING HAVE BEEN MADE FROM INSIDE. HOWEVER THERE SEEMS TO BE A SMALL SPACE WHICH PELLETS ARE ABLE TO GET OUT FROM.





ON THE NORTH SIDE OF THE BUILDING (BETWEEN PP1 SILOS AND BAGGING/SHIPPING BUILDING, UNDER THE GRATING PELLETS AND POWDER WERE OBSERVED. FURTHER INVESTIGATION UPSTREAM AND DOWN STREAM INDICATES THE CONCRETE DITCHES HAVE BEEN SWEPT, HOWEVER DEBRIS STILL LIES UNDER THE GRATING.





AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER, PELLETS AND POWDER WERE OBSERVED JUST OUTSIDE THE CULVERT AREA.





AT THE TRUCK LOADING AREA FROM THE FIRST PHOTO BELOW PELLETS CAN BE SEEN ON THE PAVEMENT.
