

OBSERVATIONS

- PE1/PP1 Bagging/Shipping
 - Pellets observed around door on the north side of the building.
 - Pellets and powder found in ditch north of building.
 - Truck Loading area, pellets and powder observed on pavement as well as on loading ramp.
 - Pellets observed by screens off gate 2 road in front of the bagging/shipping area.

ON THE NORTH SIDE OF THE BUILDING JUST ACROSS THE STREET FROM THE PP1 SILOS, PELLETS WERE OBSERVED AT THE BASE OF THE DOOR. FROM INSIDE THE BUILDING A COVER IS IN PLACE TO KEEP PELLETS CONTAINED INSIDE, HOWEVER THERE IS A SMALL GAP WHICH IS ALLOWING PELLETS TO TRAVEL THROUGH.





IN THE DITCH NORTH OF THE BUILDING, PELLETS AND DEBRIS ARE VISIBLE IN SEVERAL AREAS.





FURTHER EAST FROM PHOTOS OF PREVIOUS SLIDE, POWDER IS VISIBLE IN THE DITCH. PILES OF POWDER HAVE ACCUMULATED IN DIFFERENT AREAS OF THE DITCH.
