

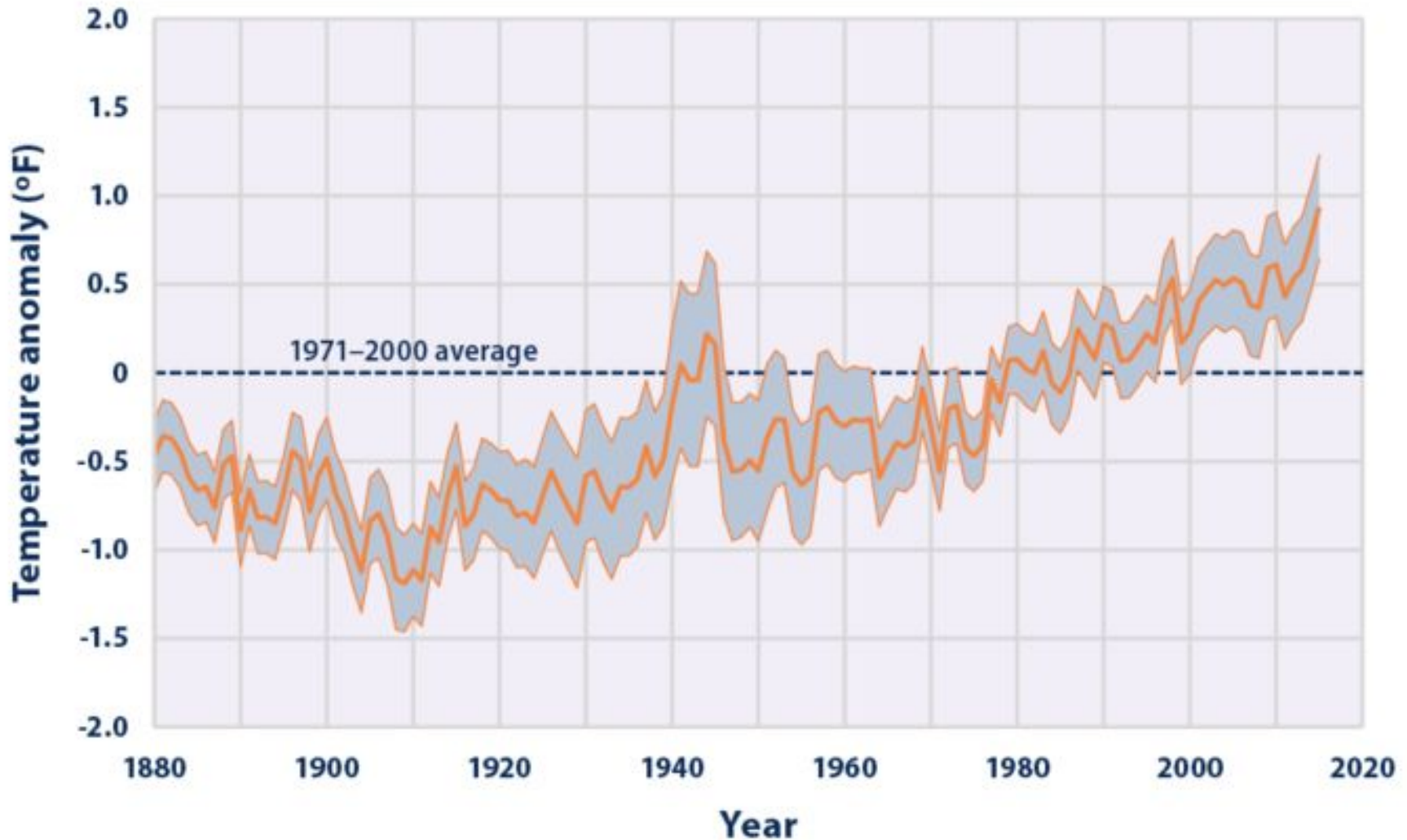
What is Climate Change?

This is ocean temperature over time

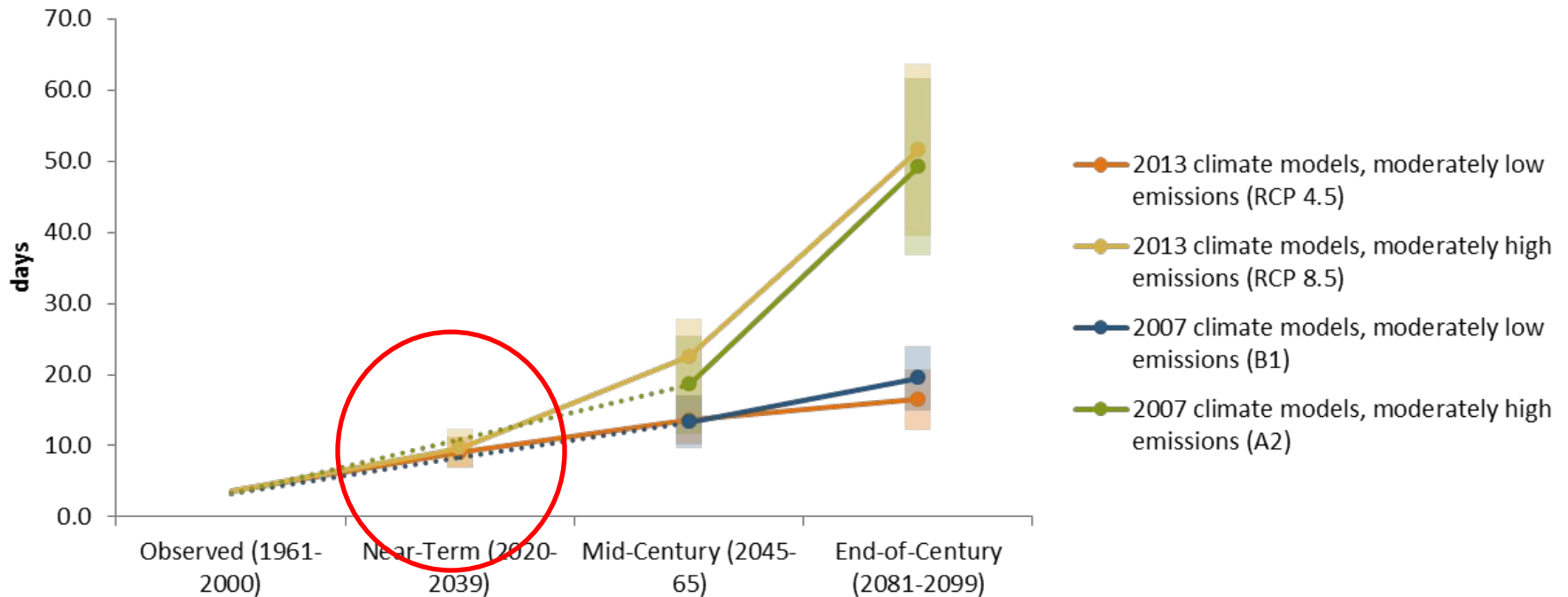




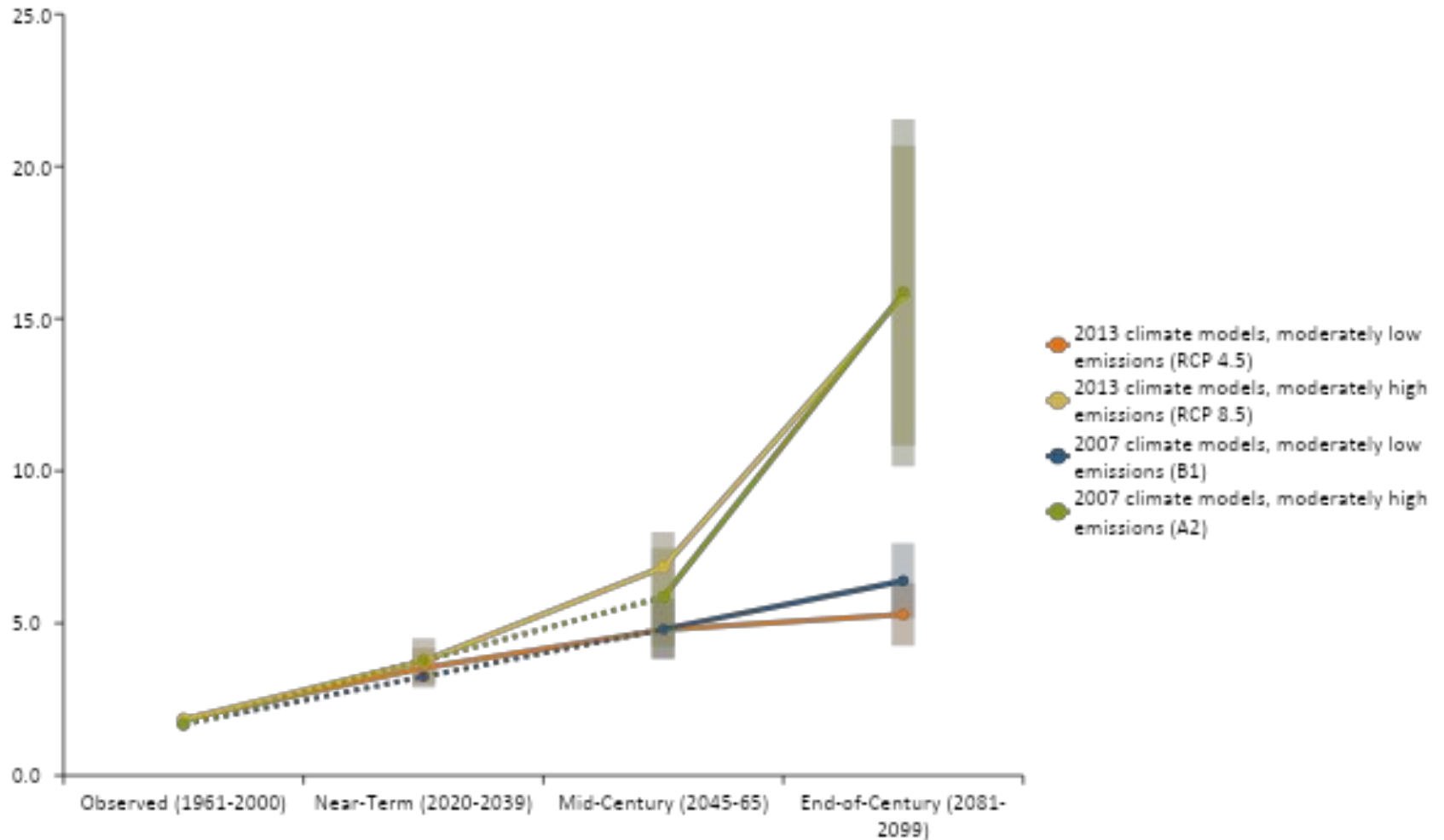
More Days of 95°F or Above

- In Philadelphia, 2016: 17 days with temperatures at or above 95°F, which exceeds the near-term projections
