Consent form for research interviews, documentation sharing and release of personal identifiers (updated 2.2023)

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You are being asked to participate in a social science study of environmental injustice and governance affiliated with the Environmental Injustice Global Record project, hosted by UCI's EcoGovLab and the <u>Disaster-STS Network</u>. Participation is completely voluntary and will not be compensated.

Researchers involved in this study will collect interviews with people who have been involved in environmental governance through work in government agencies, community-based organizations, environmental advocacy organizations, environment-focused media, and scientific research. Interviewees will be asked questions about the roles they have played in environmental governance, and about their vision for improved environmental governance. Study researchers will also collect and analyze documentation related to environmental governance (including government and community reports, photographs and video, etc).
